

## ***Existing Construction***

- If you are applying for a permit for a structure that has already been built, be aware that you may be required to expose or remove certain construction components such as sheetrock, plywood, insulation, electrical panel covers, or other materials to allow inspection of items that have been concealed and require inspection. If your structure is placed on a concrete foundation that has not been previously inspected by the City of Livermore, a building permit will *not* be issued unless a California licensed architect or registered civil or structural engineer will “certify” the existing foundations capacity to safely support the intended building loads.
- If no permits were issued, the construction must meet the current California code requirements in addition to any local amendments and ordinances.
- If only parts of the construction have been inspected through a previous permit, only those items that had no inspections will be required to be exposed for inspection.

*As the property owner you are required to sign the following statement:*

As the owner of the property located at, \_\_\_\_\_, I/we am aware that the application for a permit to construct a/an \_\_\_\_\_ is for work already completed and I/we hereby agree that the City of Livermore is authorized to require that I/we remove any building components required to expose work for inspection.
