Annual Sidewalk Repair Program

2016-2017 Sidewalk Repair Program

2016-2017 Sidewalk Repair Program, Project 2017-02 is currently in design. This project will repair damaged sidewalks at various locations throughout the City. Owners of properties adjacent to a sidewalk are responsible for maintenance of the sidewalk. The City has a cost sharing program, where the property owner pays 75% of the cost of repairs. There is a maximum cap of \$2,123 for owner-occupied residential properties. The list of locations included in the project is established through inventories conducted by City staff, and notices received from the public and property owners. Staff evaluates the condition of sidewalks in high pedestrian locations, such as Downtown, parks and schools every year. Typically, the City does an annual sidewalk repair project.
