

**Clean Water Grants** --Attention homeowners associations, youth organizations and community groups! The Clean Water Program seeks grant applications for up to \$5,000 to encourage grassroots community action that prevents stormwater pollution and enhances the health of local watersheds, creeks, and the San Francisco. Examples include litter reduction, art projects, creekside restoration, development of educational materials, and more. **Water Conservation** – Livermore residents have done a great job conserving water over the past two years. Please don't stop now despite an El Nino year. The drought is not over. Most reservoirs throughout the state are still less than 50% full, and the Sierra snowpack is only 88% of normal with our traditional rainy season ending in early spring. Continue to use water wisely.



**Women in Aviation** – The Livermore Airport, in conjunction with Women of Aviation International, will celebrate "Women of Aviation Week" on Friday, March 11, 2016 from 9:30 am – 2 pm. The program includes presentations from local women pilots, flight instructors, Air Traffic Controllers, and others in the aviation community.
